

4-Cycle Dirtbike (Kickstart Units) Starting Procedures

Read your owner's manual! This is very important for proper operation and long life of your off-road vehicle.

- 1.) Check oil level in engine for proper level.
- 2.) Check all nuts/bolts and fasteners for proper tightness.
- 3.) Using proper charger, charge battery through one complete cycle of the battery charger.
- 4.) Fill fuel tank with premium unleaded fuel.
- 5.) Check tires for proper inflation.
- 6.) Pull up on choke lever (located on carburator).
- 7.) Locate fuel inline valve and turn to 'on' position.
- 8.) Check to see that the red 'kill switch' button is in the proper position otherwise the unit will not start.
- 9.) Locate the 'choke' lever and move it to the 'open' position.
- 10. Locate kickstart foot lever. Locate twist throttle: twist open one to two times to let some fuel into carburator. Grab onto bike securely and kick the kickstart two to four times. Next, move choke lever to 'closed' position, then kick the kickstart two to four times. *If the unit starts with the choke on, it is best to let it warm up one to two minutes (three to five minutes in cooler temperatures) before turning choke off to resume normal operation.
