



ATV Care & Maintenance Tips (ATVs/Dirtbikes/4 Cycle)

"Before Your First Ride"

- 1.) Go over every nut, bolt and fastener and check for proper tightness. (From the wheels to the alarm box!)
- 2.) Check oil level and tire inflation pressures.
- 3.) Lubricate chain with a spray 'chain lube'.
- 4.) Using proper charger, charge battery through one complete cycle of the battery charger.
- 5.) Check brakes, ride controls and safety equipment for proper operation.
- 6.) Fill fuel tank with proper fuel.
- 7.) Set speed control to proper setting to match the rider's level of experience.
- 8.) Outfit the rider with a helmet and safety gear and have fun! Safety first!

"After Your First Ride" (2 hours of ride time!)

- 1.) After two hours of ride time, you must change the oil in the unit's engine. This is crucial to the life of the engine! Consult dealer or owner's manual for type/amount of oil.
- 2.) Adjust tire pressures. The front tires should be inflated to keep them more firm and upright for better steering and the rear tires should be inflated to make the tires a bit squatty for better traction. See User Manual for proper tire pressures.
- 3.) Once again, go over every nut, bolt and fastener and check for proper tightness. (From the wheels to the alarm box!)
